- Preference for previous teaching experience in undergraduate or graduate program and established record of scholarship/research publications and service.
- Two (2) years of full-time, or equivalent, clinical experience as a practicing registered nurse and/or teaching expertise in mental health, acute care or FNP.
- A current, unrestricted RN licensure in the State of Tennessee or eligibility for licensure in Tennessee.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will remain open until the position is filled.
