

## **Assistant Professor of Nursing**

Interest in teaching best-practices in maternal/newborn for undergraduate nursing students required. Additional course assignments may include entry-level clinical coursework or community health nursing. This is a 10-month, non-tenure track faculty appointment scheduled to begin on August 1, 2023. Classes and clinicals will be held in Knoxville, Tennessee.

- An earned master's or doctoral degree in nursing from an accredited institution.
- Current unencumbered RN license to practice in Tennessee.
- Licensed RN with three to five years of clinical practice experience required.
- Certification in maternal/newborn nursing preferred.
- One to two years teaching experience in a registered nursing education curriculum at the associate, baccalaureate, or diploma level preferred.
